



Pictured above it our Byanzurt (Rich Heart) Baptist Bible Institute's choir. We are so thankful for the attitude of the Lord's people in Mongolia. This year's attendance has remained one of the best ever throughout the cold temperatures of winter. We have people coming from everyone of our 5 churches. Some traveling 125 miles to 225 miles to attend.

It is so good to get through February! Toward the very end of the month temperatures started to rise above 0F during the day. With the beginning of March we have



seen temperatures reach into the high 20s. With the warmer temperatures we will be able begin remodeling the third floor of our Church building in Yarmag. The entire third floor will be opened up and be set up as our auditorium.

Remodel work continued slowly through the winter in Uginoor. It was decided that the baptistry would be

built beneath the floor of the pulpit area. The stage would be lifted up when someone was to be baptized. They do not have running water yet, so the baptistry will have to be filled one bucket at a time from the hand pumped well outside. A deep well was dug outside so the water could be pumped out of the baptistry after each use. Without an indoor baptistry they can baptize only a few months out of the year. The nearby river and lake remain frozen almost 6 months a year.



The Lord has been busy in Choir. In January three people were baptized. In the last report I wrote about the joy of Bat-erdene.

From trying to commit suicide a few short years ago, to seeing all of his family saved and members of the Lord's Church. I



didn't have space to make a note of the older gentlemen who was also baptized. Pastor Agii had been trying to help him with his alcohol problem since 2009. Pastor Agii never gave up on him.

Then in February another four professed salvation and were baptized. Three of these that were baptized are second generation Baptist. We are praising God for those families who are desiring to raise Godly children.
