It was another great month at Yarmag New Testament Baptist Church. In August, 4 members were added by baptism, in September another 5 have been added to our membership. Pictured above is Brother Carrell with those baptized on the first Sunday of September. The young boy on the left is the son of Erdenbayer the former pastor at Uginoor. The other three are an entire family. The father's name is Pujee and he had been helping with the remodel of the sanctuary and has been attending services for at last 4 months. He had been studying Shamanism, (one who connects to the spirit realm for divination and healing) but through the witness of God's people at Yarmag he has come to accept Jesus as the Christ and now his entire family has followed him. His son, Sodbaatar, had been attending along with his father this entire time. The mother, Tyngaa, was the last member to accept Christ. The son gave an account of an incident that happened just before the salvation of his mother. Sodbaatar had put his shoes next to a box in their home. Tyngaa told him to not do that because she had put her sacred statue of her god Buddha in the box. The young boy exclaimed what he had learned in SS. There is only one God, the Father of Jesus.
