Two years ago he hadn't even heard about the saving grace of Christ. He was addicted to alcohol and sentenced to Mongolia's alcohol rehab center. It was there he met our two brothers who go there every week to present the only true way of recovery. When he returned to Ulaanbaatar, Brother Erdenebayer began picking him up for services and in a very short while he came before the church professing Christ as his Savior and asking to be accepted into the Lord's church. He was baptized and began a road of recovery and commitment to serve God in the church. He is a very good artist and has put his talent to work in many different areas of church work. Second, in this picture you see this little girl holding the New Testament to her chest. This is the translation of the King James Version that is now in the hands of all of our church members, as well as being used in several other countries. We continue in the daily work of translating the Old Testament into Mongolian. Third, this picture was taken in the village of Uginoor. Uginoor is the location of the fourth church planted by the work here. Each of these churches

are pastored by Mongolian men, and each pastor is a solid Landmark Missionary Baptist. It is the desire of this work to plant another church in the suburbs of Ulaanbaatar in the very near future. And finally this little girl represents a new generation of Mongolians who are being raised with an understanding that there is a Creator of this universe who died for them that they may be free from the penalty of sin. This is the work that God has laid on our hearts to do. All who have given to the support of the work have an equal part in what has been accomplished so far. We are so thankful for all who pray for and sacrificially give that we can continue to produce pictures like the one here.
