DESIRE FOR A CHURCH IN NALAIKH

(Pronounced naa-lack)

The first week of October we went to Narlack to look at some possible meeting places. We enlisted the help of Almaa, the real-estate agent that helped in the purchase of the building in Uginoor. He found several locations for us to look at, a couple of restaurants that would rent to us by the hour, an expense office that could be converted into a meeting place and three other locations. Two were owned by the government which we ruled out immediately. There was really only one place that would work for our needs. It was in the perfect location, right in the heart of town. It was directly behind, and in the same building, of a well known restaurant, so everyone would know where it was located. It was just over 800 sq ft and could easily be converted for church use. Our agent and the building manager gave us the indication that it would cost about \$400 a month. The owner was in Korea and was to return that next Monday. All indications are that when he heard that Americans were interested in renting, the price doubled to \$800 with no negotiation. We are still looking and ask you pray with us about this need.
