Flaming Cliffs, Gobi Desert Mongolia

REPORT FOR JUNE AND JULY 2015

This June and July we had the privilege of having Jason Rambo visit the churches here. He is a professional photographer and will be producing a video that we hope to send out to all of our supporting or interested churches. Since he was coming to Mongolia we took the opportunity to take a 1000 mile trip around Mongolia. All but about 100 miles was on dirt trails and roads. Pictured above is our silhouette on top of what is called the Flaming Cliffs.

GREAT VISIT TO UGINOOR

Half way though our trip we spent the weekend with the church in Uginoor. For the last few months plans



have been drawn up and a location had been found to build a permanent building

to house the church. We found a plot of land and had settled on a small 1300 sq ft two story building. The top floor would be a parsonage and the bottom would be the sanctuary. While staying at our usual "hotel" the owner approached us with an amazing offer. Over the years we have developed a good relationship with him and he told us he wanted to sell his building to us and thought it would be great that Christians would have it. This is an amazing building and with the 5 rooms used for the hotel all the cost for electricity and coal for heat would be covered. It is located at the very center of Uginoor right next to the Government offices. It is 8600 sq feet and well built, with too many features for space to allow me to tell you. We are now in the process of purchasing this building.

TRANSLATION WORK CONTINUES

The first of June we completed the first five books of the Old Testament. We decided to go ahead and print 300 copies for our churches. We used a publisher in Mongolia and it is a hardback copy that will wear well. As you all know we have completed the translation of the K J V New



Testament into Mongolian. Now we have started another project. Armazia, a member of Rich Heart Church since 2006, is blind and teaches children at a blind school here in UB. Three of her students have been saved and are members also. This summer we have hired her and a helper to take the Mongolian NT and publish it into braille. This is a big undertaking and will take most of the rest of this year.



God is also opening a door in a near by town to start our next church. Please keep this in prayer as we seek God's will.
